

Extended Elangomat Award

1. **Purpose** – This award recognizes Elangomats who have successfully helped members of their group fulfill the trail to Brotherhood, as well as encouraged others to serve as Elangomats.
2. **ELGIBILITY** – This award may be earned by any Lodge member.
3. **AWARD TIME** – Elangomats will have fourteen (14) months from the date of the Ordeal in which they served as Elangomats to earn the Award. The Award is given for service rendered to one particular group at one Ordeal.
4. **RECOGNITION** – All awards earned throughout the year shall be presented at the Annual Dinner.
5. **AWARD** – The award is a medal worn on the Scout Uniform. The medal features an eagle in a circle with the words ‘162 Extended Elangomat Award’ written on the circle. The medal is suspended from a black ribbon with a white arrow.
6. **REQUIREMENTS** – All of the requirements must be met in order to earn the Award:
 1. Receive proper training to be an Elangomat
 2. Serve as an Elangomat at an Ordeal
 3. Seventy-five percent (75%) of the Elangomat’s group must become Brotherhood members of Migisi Opawgan.
 4. Recruit another Elangomat
6. **VERIFICATION** – A form will be made available listing the requirements. This form may be signed by the Lodge or Chapter Adviser.
